

PRIVACY POLICY

This policy, which we ask you to read carefully, shows how Int3 Software AB ("We", "EQU8" or the "Service") treats your personal information.

The most important thing about this policy is that we value and protect your rights and privacy.

The policy has been prepared in accordance with applicable legislation and EU Regulation (2016/679) on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free flow of such data, known as the "GDPR".

EQU8 processes personal data of players or other end-users ("Player" or "You") who play or otherwise use the game publisher's online video game or related services (the "Game") when providing services to the game publisher.

Below we explain how we use the personal information that is shared with us in order to provide our Services.

The policy will give you an understanding of what information we collect and what we do and don't do with it so that you can make an informed decision regarding your relationship with us.

Data Controller

Int3 Software AB, 559077-6752, Holtermansgatan 1 A, 411 29 Gothenburg, offers innovative services and technology enabling companies to discover and prevent players from cheating when playing online multiplayer games, hereinafter referred to as "Services". Int3 Software AB is the controller of the processing of the personal data that you share with us when you:

- Play games which use our services.

How & why do we process personal data?

The purpose of processing personal data is to provide cheat and fraud detection and prevention solutions in the game. In practice this means information is gathered of the Players interacting with the Game and the gathered information is exchanged between our Services and the game studio / publisher.

EQU8 may use the following personal data from you:

- The IP address or other unique identifier such as a device identifier of any of your computer(s) or device(s) that are used to access the Game
- Integrity of the Game environment and assets or alike (e.g. memory, files, etc)
- Running software, drivers and other executable code

- Technical information related to the running operating system and hardware used to play the Game
- Technical information about the processes, strategies, technology or the like that you use in the game that may be suspicious methods that the game publisher finds unacceptable
- Other equivalent information

In addition, EQU8 may use automated decision-making when processing your personal data in order to achieve its purpose in an effective manner.

EQU8 only runs when the game does.

Who do we share personal data with?

Your data will be shared with the game publisher and the service providers on a regular basis to prevent or investigate misuse within the game and to the extent necessary to implement penalties.

Your personal data will not be sold, leased, licensed, lent or otherwise delegated or transmitted to third parties other than those set out in this Privacy Policy: data may be stored handled by data processors such as Amazon Web Services (with which we have entered into a data transfer agreements), both inside and outside of the EU/EEA. If the company (Int3 Software AB) is redeemed, sold or otherwise allocated to the Service or the shares of EQU8, the Player data may be passed to the buying party or the business.

How long do we save your personal data?

We save personal data about you as a Player as long as there is a Game relationship, or it is necessary to achieve the purposes described in this policy. Upon termination of our Services, we will delete or anonymize your personal data within a reasonable period of time after the termination of the customer relationship, unless other Swedish or European law, court or authority says otherwise. Information collected when you contact us is stored as long as we have a commitment to you. Upon termination of commitment, we may store your data based on the balance of legitimate interests as evidence in the event of a recurrence of the matter.

Your rights

You are entitled to request a registry extract of any personal data that is registered about you, free of charge once a year, provided you have legitimate reasons. You are entitled to have your personal data corrected if incorrect, completed, erased or restrict the processing of personal data until they are changed. You have the right to be forgotten, but deletion of personal data cannot be done if it is required to fulfill an agreement or if other Swedish or European law, court or government decision states otherwise, and if it is based on a balance of legitimate interests.

You will not access information that includes trade secrets or intellectual property, like the information used to detect hacking techniques. Should you find that there is no legitimate reason, or the balance of interest is incorrect, you may object to the processing. You also have the right to withdraw a consent, make complaints about the processing to the Data Authority, automatically oppose decision making, profiling.

Data processor

In the event that we act as a data processor of personal data that you control, we acknowledge that we will only process and use personal data, for which you are the Data Controller, in accordance with the GDPR and other relevant applicable privacy laws and your specific instructions.
